Saeed Muzafar Ali

July 1, 1947 - April 6, 2020

Saeed Muzafar Ali was born on July 1, 1947 and passed away on April 6, 2020 at his home in Mar Vista. He was born in India during the tumult of the partition after British rule and was the oldest son of a family that grew to seven siblings. His family home in Aligarh, Abid Manzil, was a mystical place in my childhood mind as he told story after story of mango tree groves, libraries of books, enlightened neighbors and good foods. In his 20's he traveled the world, through Iran, Hong Kong, Hawaii and finally to California on a Fulbright Scholarship to UCLA where he met his wife, Mary. He had three sons and four grandchildren.

He lived a life of service to the community. While working for State Senator Tony Mendoza, Saeed Ali was instrumental helping *Eco-Rapid Transit* secure Measure M funding for the West Santa Ana Branch and pushing that it become a public private partnership project to meet a 2028 project completion deadline. More than that – he was a mentor and a friend who cared about our community.
